These responsibilities require the Quality Engineer to analyze Purchase Order, Statement of Work, Specification Documentation and all related procurement requirements, organize and generate an approach at the supplier or to be performed by receiving inspection to validate compliance. These systems are for both Military and Commercial applications and individual must be knowledgeable in both.

Bachelor's Degree in related field plus 7-10 years directly related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Detailed knowledge of Quality Requirements used in industry; thorough familiarity with ISO 9000, AS9100, MIL-Q-9858, MIL-I-45208, J-STD-001, MIL-STD-454, MIL-STD-45662, IPC-A-610 required. Experience performing final inspection and sell off and witnesses testing at all suppliers. Ability to act as liaison with customers and between departments and make independent decisions to insure adherence to contractual quality requirements and corporate procedures. Must be PC literate with working knowledge of MS office applications including Word and Excel etc. Must have a background that would permit the issuance of a Security clearance, which includes US citizenship.
