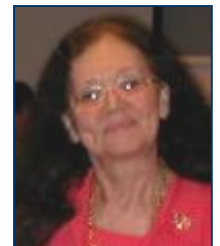

Principles for Cultivating Café Dialogue

7. Harvest and share **collective discoveries**

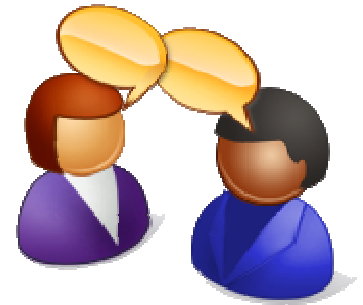
Setting the Context

Elements:

- **P**urpose
- **P**articipants
- **P**arameters

Explore Question That Matter

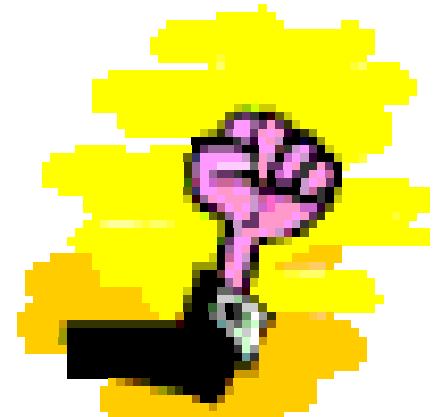
What is **your** most memorable event
